

Ashley Woods, Section III Homeowners Association
POOL RULES

*The Ashley Woods Pool is a Private Pool.
All guests must be accompanied by an adult resident.*

Access & Hours:

1. Only owners who are current on Association Dues
2. 8:00 AM to 9:00 PM
3. Exceptions: weather, and when a "Closed" sign is posted.

Restrictions:

1. Any child younger than thirteen (13) years old must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older) resident while swimming in the pool.
2. All pool furniture must be kept at least four feet from the pool.
3. Please keep pool umbrellas lowered when not in use. It helps to prevent damage caused by wind. If you are the last to leave the pool area, everyone would appreciate it if you would lower the umbrellas to prevent any damage.

Attire:

1. Appropriate and suitable swimwear is required. Cut-offs and thongs of any kind are not acceptable.

Guests:

1. The Ashley Woods Pool is a *private* pool. Pool guests are limited to four (4) per family and must be accompanied by an adult resident.
2. Exception: Guests for a Cabana reservation are limited to 25 people and must also be accompanied by an adult resident.
3. **Adult** "out-of-town" guest staying/living with you may use the pool without you being present during their visit. Guests are not permitted to have guests.

Private Events:

1. The entire fenced-in pool area cannot be reserved exclusively but the Cabana area can be reserved for private events however everyone must be mindful of members and guests in the pool.

Sanitation Requirements:

1. Any person with skin abrasion, cold, coughs, infections or communicable disease of any kind or anyone wearing bandages will not be allowed in the pool.
2. All children who are not toilet trained must wear a waterproof diaper cover that is advertised acceptable and approved for pool use. Parents may be held responsible for all accidents resulting in closing the pool and cleaning costs.
3. No diapers are to be thrown into trashcans.
4. Sunbathers using suntan lotion must cover chairs or chaise lounge with towels.

5. Please wipe down all chairs when leaving the pool.
6. All trash, cartons, cigarette butts, matches, etc; must be placed in the trash containers provided.
7. Flowerpots are not ashtrays. Please dispose of your cigarette butts in appropriate containers.

General Prohibition:

1. No equipment or furniture may be removed from the fenced in pool area.
2. Small rafts and floats are allowed in the shallow end of the pool only. Water wings may be used as a safety device. Remove all toys from the pool area when leaving.
3. For the safety of all, running, ball playing, horse-playing, roughhousing or any conduct that is boisterous, harmful or not conducive to proper pool behavior is not permitted. You will be asked to leave the pool area.
4. Loud music is not allowed.
5. Chewing gum and hard candy is not allowed in the pool area.
6. Diving **is not** allowed.
7. Pets of **any kind** are not allowed in the pool area. This is a rule dictated by the Board of Health.
8. No portable grills are allowed at the pool area.
9. Food is not allowed in the pool area. Exception: Allowed in Cabana area.
10. **No glass** of any kind is allowed in the pool area.

Liability:

1. There is no lifeguard on duty.
2. The Association is not responsible for any loss or damage to personal property brought into the pool area.
3. Residents are responsible for any damage caused by themselves or their guests.
4. Any people using the pool do so at their own risk.

Responsibility:

It is the responsibility of Every Resident to see that their children and/or guests are aware of the pool rules and comply with them. Any parent or child will be held responsible for loss of use or damage to the pool. Any resident who observes theft or vandalism should immediately report this information to the local authority and then Legacy Association Management.

It serves the benefit of our community to remember that having the pool and being able to use it is a privilege and an amenity for all owners. We need resident cooperation to keep the pool clean and make it work for the good and safety of all residents and their guests.
